### **President Janet Zabukovic's Message**



Dear Fellow Serrans:

Thanksgiving has passed. Advent has arrived, and the flurry of activity in preparation for Christmas has officially begun! Like many of you, I will be busy decorating, buying gifts for loved ones, sending Christmas cards, and thinking about holiday foods.

But today, I took some time to just sit quietly and think. Advent is a season of preparation. For the first half of Advent, we look forward as we anticipate Christ's second coming. The second half of Advent is a time to prepare oneself for the celebration of the birth of our Savior in the form of a tiny, helpless baby. Timothy Brunk, an associate professor of theology and religious studies at Villanova University, explains the two parts of Advent in this way, "Christ who has come is also coming. Advent, like Christmas, looks back but also looks forward." He also wrote that even though Advent is about preparation for Christmas, it is also about "assessing how one has

welcomed the Christ who has come and one's readiness for the Christ who is coming."

We can prepare by making more time to pray and by setting aside time each day to reflect on scripture and to reflect on where we are in our preparation for eternal life. Many of our churches make Advent materials available to guide us during this season. We have to be mindful in preparing our spiritual selves for Christmas so as to not get so absorbed with the holiday preparations that the real meaning of Advent is lost in our busyness.

As a Serran, we should also remember to pray for our seminarians as they prepare themselves for the Priesthood, and for our Priests who are fulfilling their vocations in service to God and to us, the Body of the Church. Think about the beauty of the Advent and Christmas Seasons in the Catholic Church, and remember that without our Priests, there would be no Mass, no Eucharist, and no Sacraments! Take time during the busyness of this season to let your seminarian know that

you are keeping them in prayer. Take time to thank the priests in your life for their vocation and to let them know how important and appreciated they are in your life.

May your Advent be a time of spiritual reflection and prayer as we wait in anticipation for the coming of the Baby Jesus!


