Dear Fellow Serrans:

#### **Additional Message from our President**

As many of you probably already know, a new Catholic High School will be located in Colorado Springs beginning next school year. The school has been recognized and approved by Bishop Sheridan as a Catholic school. The official name of the new school will Our Lady of Walsingham; the school is party of the Chesterton Academy Schools that have locations in several places in the United States. I have attached a document with more information about the school. The school has not yet found a permanent location, but for at least the first year, the school will be located at St. Gabriel's Parish and Fr. Brian Roeseler is scheduled to be the chaplain.

I was contacted by one of the board members with information about a fundraising gala for the new school. The gala is scheduled for May 1st from 5:30 PM until 10:00 PM at The Pinery at the Hill. There will be a dinner, a guest speaker and a silent auction. Further information about this event is given in the attachment. Our Serra Club has been offered the opportunity to sponsor a table of 8 for the gala. The cost of the table sponsorship is \$500. While individual tickets are available for \$60 for a single or \$100 for a couple, sponsoring a table would guarantee that the 8 people could sit together for the gala. Several people have already expressed interest in attending and sponsoring a table. This will be a fun event and because a big focus of the new school is on fostering the development of the Catholic faith and fostering vocations among the students, forming a relationship with the school could be a great avenue for our work in fostering vocations and may also allow us to meet fellow Catholics who may be interested in joining Serra.


