

We will begin with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the St John Henry Newman Chapel at 11:30 AM.


Followed by Mass at 12 noon, celebrated by Fr Kyle Ingels.

April 22, 1925 - May 14, 2021

Dennis J. Hayes passed away on May 14, 2021 with his beloved wife Mary of almost 73 years and his children by his side. He was 96 years old.

Dennis was born on April 22, 1925 in Mankato, Minnesota, eldest son to James J. Hayes and Glenna Lortz. He grew up in Mankato, graduated from Loyola High School, and served our country in the US Navy during WWII (from 1943-1946). Upon returning to the US, Denny found the love of his life, Mary O. Heinzman, and the two were married on June 23, 1948.

Dennis and Mary relocated to Colorado to raise their family. Dennis was a communications specialist while in the Navy, enjoyed his time as a DJ for radio stations including KRDO in Colorado Springs, and worked primarily in sales for the majority of his career. His love of music, especially playing and teaching organ music, led him to owning the House of Baldwin from which he retired from after 15 years. As a lifelong and committed Catholic, Dennis served in leadership roles in the Knights of Columbus and was an active member of St. Mary's Cathedral community for over 50 years. Dennis loved the mountains of Colorado, often referring to his chosen home as "God's Country."

Dennis leaves behind so many who will miss him – His beloved Mary, his children and spouses Pat (Bobbi), Michael (Sherell), Tim (Kathy), Kathy (Tom), Terry (Lin), Julie (Relly), and Shawn (Carla), his 17 grandchildren, and his 20 great grandchildren, along with his baby sister and brother, Margaret Pahl and James Hayes and a multitude of nephews and nieces. His beloved daughter Denise proceeded him in death, and is glad to be reunited with her daddy now.
