### President Janet Zabukovic's Message

Dear Fellow Serrans,

We are now entering the penitential season of Lent in preparation for Easter. Lent is designed for reflection and for preparation for Christ's Passion and Resurrection. Each year at this time, we think about what we want to do or give up during Lent. We are called to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving during this season. Today, I watched a video by Fr. Mike Schmitz, who is likely familiar to most of you. Fr. Mike encouraged us to pick something in each of those three areas as our Lenten penances. He suggested we pick one prayer related thing to do that will draw us closer to God, something like spending 15 minutes reading scripture and reflecting on what we read. For fasting, he reminded that fasting does not have to be restricted to food or drink but can include anything in our life whose absence or smaller presence would help us to purify our life and conform us more to living as Jesus taught- something like giving up some of the time we spend on social media or watching television or movies and spending that time in a different way. Finally, for almsgiving, he talked about it not being restricted to money things but also can mean giving time and treasure to others. He talked about discipline as being a good trait that is focused on us and what we do and generosity being a good trait that is focused on others. He said that discipline doesn't expand the heart, but generosity does.

Perhaps the most thought provoking idea he shared was that the best place to start as we identify our Lenten sacrifices was by going to God in prayer and asking this question; "God, what is it that you want me to give to you this Lent?"

During this Lenten Season, as we prepare ourselves to focus on the Passion of Christ and then rejoice in his Resurrection, I encourage each of us to imagine Lent and Easter without a Priest! That is the reality for some Catholics who do not have regular access to a priest and the Sacraments. Let's remember to add some extra prayers for an increase in vocations, for those in formation and for those discerning. This is a very busy time for our priests so don't forget to thank them for their vocations and for shepherding us through this very special season.

Pope Francis appealed again today, Feb. 27, for an end to the war in Ukraine, for "the silencing of the guns" and the opening of humanitarian corridors to those fleeing the war. "God is with those who work for peace, not with those who use violence," he said.

"I invite everyone to make March 2, Ash Wednesday, a day of prayer and of fasting for peace in Ukraine," he said, repeating his appeal of last week. He called on people to make it "a day to be close to the suffering of the people of the Ukraine, a day to feel that we are all brothers and sisters and to implore God for the end of the war."
