PARISH VOCATION MINISTRY TRAINING MEETING OCT 30 REPORT

The Parish Vocation Ministry Training was held at the Newman Center on Saturday, October 30. During the workshop, the participants from their respective parish devised a draft mission statement, goal(s), objectives, and action plan to help prepare them to establish a vocation ministry in their respective parish with their pastor's approval. The trainers provided the attendees with excellent handouts and resources. Four of our St. Serra Club members were representatives of their respective parishes. Fourteen Serrans attended the training. Several of our members plan to volunteer to serve as a mentor to their assigned parish. Dr. Roat will assign the participating parish vocation ministry a mentor for one year. Several of our members assisted Fr. Kyle in hosting the workshop. SERRA DISTRICT 6 CONVENTION REPORT

Serra District 6 Convention was held at St. John Henry Newman Catholic Student Center October 22–23, 2021 and hosted by our Colorado Springs Serrans. District 6 encompasses all three Dioceses in Colorado which totals 9 Serra Clubs, all of which were represented. The theme this year was "God's Call to Holiness Transcends Generations."

Friday evening began with a wine social in the Library of the Student Center where attendees could view displays of our major sponsors who helped fund the convention. We are grateful for their generosity. This was followed by our Convention Dinner catered by You and I Caterers. Our Keynote Speaker was Mr. Richard Arians, President of Serra USA, who spoke on "Recognizing Our Call to Holiness."

Saturday was a very full day, attended by 72 participants with 8 more speakers. Following Mass and Breakfast, our own Father Kyle Ingels opened the convention, followed by Fr. Carl Wertin of the Diocese of Pueblo Vocations. Both gave insights about the generations that will be providing Vocations in the near future, while Tyler Kluzak, UCCS student, gave us a window into college life as it is today. After lunch from WhichWich, we listened to two of our own Serrans, Doug Berg from Pueblo and Nancy Akers from Aurora, speak of how God has worked in their lives. Serrans chose one of three workshops to attend: Jessica Harris of Fort Collins who does spiritual direction with students from CSU; our own Charlene Pardo who grew up in Carmel, CA, one of Fr. Junipero Serra's missions and knows so much about our Patron; and Sr. Quynh Phan, a Salesian, whose joy in her vocation is evident in all she speaks.

Serra District Awards were presented throughout the day with Colorado Springs receiving five of the eight to include the Outstanding Club Award accepted by our President, Jan Zabukovic. Several door prizes, donated by various sponsors, churches, and individuals, were given away at the close of our very successful and enlightening convention.
