Holy Days of Obligation for 2023-24

All Sundays are obligatory for the faithful to participate in Mass

Wednesday, Nov. 1, 2023 Solemnity of All Saints

Friday, Dec. 8, 2023 The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Monday, Dec. 25, 2023 Christmas

Thursday, Aug. 15, 2024 Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Friday, Nov. 1, 2024 Solemnity of All Saints

Monday, Dec. 9, 2024 The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary

These holy days of obligation are to be observed in Latin rite dioceses, with the following amendment: Whenever January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption, or November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints, falls on a Saturday or on a Monday, the precept to attend Mass is abrogated. This decree was

made December 13, 1991, by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops.

The Laws of Fast and Abstinence

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has determined that the following practice shall prevail in the United States: Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for all those who have celebrated their 18th birthday and have not yet celebrated their 60th birthday. Abstinence from meat is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent by all who have celebrated their 14th birthday. The faithful are also encouraged to observe Ember Days through prayer, fasting and/or abstinence or other forms of penance. Ember days are the Wednesday, Friday and Saturday following the Feast of St. Lucy (Dec. 13); following Ash Wednesday; following the Solemnity of Pentecost; and following the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.

Easter Duty

Catholics are obliged to receive the Eucharist at least once a year between Easter and Trinity Sunday (cf. Canon 920).

Catholics guilty of grave sin are obliged to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance) at least once a year (cf. Canon 989).
