Happy new liturgical year! The flurry of activity in preparation for Christmas has officially begun! As Advent begins, I have been thinking about this season of joyful anticipation during which we can prepare ourselves for celebrating the coming of Jesus in the incarnate form of a tiny, helpless baby.
