President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans:

November is a month when we seem to focus on gratitude, at least for Thanksgiving Day. But perhaps we need to develop an "attitude of gratitude" that is not restricted to a season, a month, or a day. It's not enough to "just" be grateful for our many gifts and graces; it is also imperative that we share those gifts with others. Pope St. John Paul wrote, "Your being increases in the measure that you give it away." He called this "the law of the gift"; we receive many gifts from God, we return some of those gifts to God through our money, time and talent, and we, in return receive far more than we have given. Bishop Baron wrote, "The act of returning to God what God has given sets us right. It returns our lives to God, and our being ends up increased."

Gratitude doesn't begin and end with what we put in the basket at Mass. As a Serran, that attitude of gratitude must extend to our gratitude for our Priests. We need to be conscious of expressing that gratitude, keeping in mind our call as a Serran to be a friend to Priests. We must express that gratitude, verbally and in works, to the priests in our lives so that they know they are loved, appreciated and trusted and that we support them in their vocation. We can show our gratitude to our seminarians by taking the time each day to pray for them as they answer God's call to the Priesthood. We can especially show our gratitude to the seminarian that we sponsor through our words of support and encouragement, and our prayers. We must show our gratitude for God's establishment of the Priesthood by praying that he sends more workers for his vineyard. This November and beyond, let us be especially purposeful about gratitude!





Five of our new men are in the spirituality year at Seminary, which means their ability to communicate is limited. They are fasting from technology to enhance inward reflection.


