Serra Club Monthly Mass, Luncheon, and Guest Speaker Thursday, April 20, 2023

Our guest speaker for April 20 will be Patrick S. J. Carmack, JD, Founder and President of the *Angelicum Academy Homeschool Program* and the *Great Books Academy Homeschool Program*. Mr. Carmack will be speaking on **The Impact of Studying the Classics on Vocations.** There is a remarkably high correlation between the study of the humanities and vocation rates. For example, since the Great Books-based Thomas Aquinas College's inception, a steady 10 percent of its alumni have pursued a vocation. There are 74 alumni priests and more than 40 fully professed religious, with many more alumni in seminaries around the country and abroad. While higher than most, a high rate of vocations is typical at Catholic Great Books programs. This talk will discuss what a Great Books program is, and possible reasons why they seem to have a dramatic impact on vocations.



Fr. Sijo George, Speaker, March 16 Luncheon

Fr. Sijo George is a Benedictine Priest from the southern state of Kerala, India. He is currently the Parochial Vicar at St. Paul Catholic Church in Colorado Springs. Fr. George spoke to the Serra Club on the topic of **Christianity in India**. Fr. George was ordained a priest in 2003. He studied formative

spirituality, taught school, and later, he was sent to Italy for two years and earned his Masters in Philosophy from the Univ of St. Anselmo Rome. He also had the wonderful experience of being on cruise ships as chaplain and as Crew Welfare Officer, which is how he met personal expenses during his studies in Italy. Fr. George most recently has been serving as the Dean of studies at St. Joseph's Institute of Philosophy in the village of Makkiyad, outside the town of Wayanad in the state of Kerala, India. He is a member of the Congregation of the Sylvestro Benedictines belonging to the Priory of St. Joseph's Monastry Makkiyad, Kerala, India
