Dear Fellow Serrans:

Today I was reflecting on how lovely it was to host the religious women this month at our annual luncheon to honor them. It was wonderful that so many were able to join us. Reflecting on the luncheon led me on a stroll down memory lane to my early days at St. Leander's Catholic School. My favorite teacher was my second-grade teacher, Sister Mary Kevin. Of course, in those days, the nuns still wore their traditional habits, so Sister Mary Kevin was in her black habit complete with a white coif framed by a black veil. She had a big black rosary and the pockets in her habit seemed to go all the way to the floor! She was beautiful! When I think back, it reminds me of those very old Bing Crosby movies where he played a Priest and there was usually a beautiful nun, often the Mother Superior, who needed his help. My fondest memory of Sister Mary Kevin happened one day on the playground when she was playing softball with us. She hit the ball and picked up her habit a bit to run the bases. We all stopped in our tracks like time had stopped and collectively let out a gasp as we saw her black stocking ankles and shoes running around the bases and the revelation hit that she had legs-

real legs!!!!! She had always seemed to float across the room! I can't help but smile at that memory.

Thinking about Sister Mary Kevin led me to reflect on some of my unique and very special Catholic memories-Midnight Christmas Mass with my family then going home for a snack and to open one present in the wee hours of Christmas morning, polishing new patent leather shoes before attending Easter Mass, the joy of celebrating a Baptism, a First Communion or Confirmation with the traditional dishes of my Slovenian heritage, the beauty of a Catholic marriage Mass, the comfort of a Catholic funeral service when one is heartbreakingly sad. I thought about the legacy of a Catholic upbringing that I hopefully gave to my son and he in return is giving to his family. Being Catholic is such a gift and I think sometimes we forget to thank those people who helped us along the way, all the way from our parents who made sure we were Baptized and brought us up in the faith, to those teachers and mentors along the way, and to all the Priests who ministered our sacraments and celebrated Mass with us over the years. I am grateful to all who have been a part of my faith journey, and that includes my fellow Serrans!

Jim Jansen, Director of Pastoral Services for the Archdiocese of Omaha, will be our speaker. His talk is titled The Fundamentals of Encounter. Jim is a cradle Catholic from Omaha, Nebraska, with over 20 years of experience in evangelization and parish renewal. At the invitation of his roommate at Benedictine College, Jim joined one of the first FOCUS Bible studies in 1999. He became a FOCUS missionary on the founding team at the Li of Nebraska Lingelp, During his 18 years on staff with

founding team at the U of Nebraska-Lincoln. During his 18 years on staff with FOCUS, Jim served as a campus missionary, team director, and regional director.

Jim now leads the Archdiocese of Omaha's efforts to coach pastors and train disciples for mission. Jim is also the host of EquipCast, a podcast produced by the Archdiocese of Omaha, designed to help pastors and leaders transform

culture. Jim holds a master's degree in Pastoral Theology from Madonna University in partnership with Ave Maria University. He and his wife, Kim, live in Bellevue, Nebraska, with their six children. Jim's new book "A Clear Path: How to Make Missionary Disciples in Your Parish" will be out soon.


