President Janet Zabukovic's Message

Dear Fellow Serrans:



I first want to thank all of you for your prayers over the last couple of months as I continue to recover from my bout with being septic with pneumonia. It has been a long and difficult journey in the hospital, then rehab, and now at home to regain my strength and recover from the pneumonia and the damage from when I passed out and fell. I laid unconscious on the floor for about 15 hours until Laura Jean Hawley and Pat Van Matre got help for me after realizing something was wrong since I was not returning texts, emails, or phone calls. I was so sick that my pastor, Fr. Jason Keas, came immediately to the hospital after Pat called and he administered last rites. When Fr. Jason visited me in rehab, he told me that I clearly had been in God's hands all those hours

and that he was certain that God was telling me my work was not yet done- I still have work to do and lessons to learn! I am beyond grateful to Pat and Laura Jean for literally saving my life, to all the medical and rehab staff who worked to help me recover, to my family and friends who have been generous with their time to help me do what I could not do, and to all who have reached out to check on me and offer their prayers. An experience like this is certainly a catalyst to reflect on the gift of life and life's fragility. It was also an abrupt lesson in humility as I know I am not as strong and independent as I thought I was. I quickly realized that we all need other people- we can't go through life alone without either people or God's grace- and there are many truly wonderful and compassionate people in the world!

Lent begins in just a few short weeks. During this Lenten Season, as we prepare ourselves to focus on the Passion of Christ and then rejoice in his Resurrection, I encourage each of us to spend extra time in prayer. Imagine Lent and Easter without a

Priest! That is the reality for some Catholics who do not have regular access to a priest and the Sacraments. Let's remember to add some extra prayers for an increase in vocations, for those in formation and for those discerning. This is a very busy time for our priests so don't forget to thank them for their vocations and for shepherding us through this very special season.

Serra Apostolate Treasurer's Report – Feb 2024

Beginning balance (Operating Account) \$4076.05

Receipts \$5485.50 Disbursements \$4950.00

Ending balance (Operating Account) \$4611.55

Ending balance (Savings Account) \$2501.64

Total Balance (Operating + Savings) \$7,113.19

Both Accounts Receivable (AR) & Accounts Payable (AP) involve only dues as all other monies owed to the club have been received and all other bills have been paid. All unpaid dues are considered AR and all dues paid beyond Jan would be an AP for the Club. Since in the first quarter of the year members decide if they will pay monthly, semi-annually, or annually, I will skip this computation until at least April.

Each January, your club treasurer must issue Internal Revenue Service mandated letters to anyone who has donated over \$250.00 to the club. The donations must be auditable and trackable to the donor. So, if you write a check as a donation to the club, that money is trackable and auditable to the donor. On the other hand, if you put a \$20 bill in a donation jar at one of the club meetings, that money is neither trackable or auditable to the donor. I have scoured our books, and I did not find any member to whom I need to issue a letter. However, I may have made a mistake. If you believe you should have received a donor letter, please call me and I will review the qualifying documents for you. Ray at 307 922 6813.

Each January and June, I pay our semi-annual dues assessment to Serra USA and Serra International. I make these payments from your dues payments. This is why it is very important to pay your dues on time. As mentioned above, you have three options to pay your annual \$120 dues or \$180 as a dues-paying couple. You can pay the entire annual dues (\$120 or \$180) all at once in the first month of the year. You can split your dues payment into two semi-annual copayments of \$60 or \$90 as a dues-paying couple. OR-- you can pay your \$10 or \$15 as a duespaying couple monthly. Whichever method you choose please be timely!! You can mail your dues payments to: The Serra Club of COS or The Serra Apostolate of COS, 228 N Cascade Ave., Colorado Springs, CO 80903. You can also give your dues payments to me at the monthly meetings or if you prefer, just call me at the above number and I will come and pick it up from you. I will send out the first dues invoices in April to those that are delinquent at that time. Thank you to all the members, guests and friends that made the Anniversary Dinner and **Silent Auction** such a huge success! Although the weather did not cooperate, we had 50 people attend the dinner and hear Lisa, our keynote speaker, give an outstanding and very informative talk. Our only fundraiser of the year, the Silent Auction set a new record for proceeds. Due to the hard work of Eleanor Gentilini and her small band of volunteers and donors, the Club received \$2,260.50 that will help us to establish our first annual budget for the board at the beginning of our fiscal year in June.

Finally, our club paid off our pledge of \$1000.00 to Serra International to help with the expenses of the Eucharistic Congress this Summer. Remember back in Sep/Oct our Board of Directors

contributed \$500.00 and then challenged the membership to match this \$500 with \$500 in donations which would all go to support the Serra International initiative to support the Eucharistic Congress this coming Summer in Indianapolis. One of the four Eucharistic Processions heading to Indianapolis will start in California and pass through Denver this Summer. It will be named the Saint Serra Trail.
