President Janet Zabukovic's Message





After graduating from the four-year Denver Catholic Biblical School and participating in the Bible in a Year podcast with Fr Mike Schmitz, I was looking for another program to enhance my faith journey. So last fall, I decided that I would participate in Fr. Schmitz's Catechism in a Year podcast. I can vividly remember my early experience with the Catholic Catechism in my Catholic grade school years. Back then, the Baltimore Catechism was used. For those not familiar with that, the Baltimore Catechism was a book of questions with scripted answers, questions such as, "Who is God?" We were expected to memorize the scripted answers and were tested on those by the Sister who taught that particular class each year. I have never been a good memorizer, so I remember the hours my poor Mom and Dad worked to help me memorize all those responses over all those years. I was able to do that after much work and, I admit, many tears of frustration. But what was missing in all that

memorization was deeper understanding about what those scripted responses actually meant. Participating in the Catechism in a Year podcasts has been a wonderful experience as Fr. Mike leads me through reading each day's Catechism section and then explains the meaning of those words and its relationship to my life. I got behind with my recent illness but am back on track and committed to spending time each evening learning more about my Catholic faith. I would highly recommend engaging in this year-long commitment.

During this Lenten Season, as we prepare ourselves to focus on the Passion of Christ and then rejoice in his Resurrection, I encourage each of us to spend extra time in prayer, reading scripture or the Catechism, and growing in relationship to God. Let's remember to add some extra prayers for an increase in vocations, for those in formation and for those discerning. This is a very busy time for our priests so don't forget to thank them for their vocations and for shepherding us through this very special season.

Serra Anniversary Dinner and Silent Auction was held Monday, Jan 15, 2024

Despite the frigid temperatures and poor road conditions, most of those planning to attend did show up with 45-50 people participating! We had a delicious catered dinner, then heard the inspiring story by Lisa Hunt, a Consecrated Virgin living in our Diocese, of how she answered her call to serve the Lord.

Serra Member Eleanor Gentilini sent a short summary of the silent auction: We took in over \$2200 on the auction. This was \$1000 more than last year. We had a total of 72 items, of which 64 received bids. Some of the more valuable items (\$100 or more) were: A large creation called "The Word Made Flesh" which consisted of the entire New Testament written in shaded script to form an image of the Body of Christ, by a Korean artist & donated by the O'Connell's; a statue of the Blessed Mother made by Goebel (Hummel) of

Germany; a colorful print of a famous painting called Virgin of the Grapes; a vacation home in upstate NY for a week or weekend. In addition, there were dozens of items available for \$10-20, as well as many in between.

While Serra is not a fundraising organization - our primary purpose is prayer and support - this annual event allows us to do more nice things for our Priests, Sisters, Deacons and Seminarians throughout the year. We look forward to seeing you there next year.

Seven Serran Prayer Program

Several years ago, the Serra US Council established a prayer program to ensure every vocation director in the US has at least one Serran praying for them for one hour each day of the year. Each Serra Club was asked to organize seven-member teams whose members agree to commit to one hour of prayer (Mass, Holy Hour, rosary, or other prayers) each week in support of their Vocation Director. The St. Serra Apostolate of CO Springs prayer team has been praying for Fr. Kyle the past year.
