Dear Fellow Serrans:

Join Scott Hahn on Saturday, April 13, at 10:00 MT.

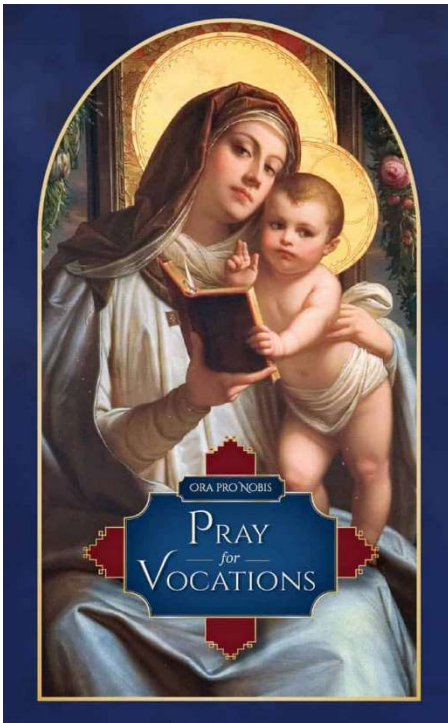


