President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans:

This weekend was the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi Sunday. We are reminded that Jesus gave us his body and blood in the form of bread and wine to sustain us after he was sacrificed on the cross for our salvation and ascended into heaven. I've been thinking about sacrifice. I'm sure we've all made sacrifices in our lives for our kids and spouses and other family members, for our jobs, for causes in which we believe and support, and for our faith. I don't remember really thinking about the things I did or continue to do as being a sacrifice, so much as for them just being something I wanted to do out of love, of faith, or because it was simply the right thing to do.

Thinking about sacrifice made me think of those who choose the path of Priesthood. These men answer God's call to serve the Church, and that includes all of us. They give up having a family of their own, making their own decisions about where to live and work, and spend countless hours each day in prayer and in service to the Catholic Church. As we in Serra have learned, the path to the Priesthood is rigorous and lengthy. Imagine the sacrifices a man makes when he accepts God's call and enters the seminary- years of study and spiritual development are ahead of him. Meanwhile, his contemporaries are starting careers, having families, traveling the world. Think of the sacrifices that a Priest makes every day- the hours spent in prayer on behalf of his flock, the late-night visits to the sick and dying, the emotional toll of sharing the grief, sorrow, worry, and fears of his flock, the holidays spent away from his biological family to serve his spiritual families who lovingly call him "Father."

Reflecting on the sacrifice that these men have made and continue to make reinforced the importance of our support of our Priests. Do we "sacrifice" time in our day to keep them in prayer? Do we "sacrifice" a little of our time to personally thank them for their work? Do we remember to include them in our lives in times when things are going well and not just when we need them because things aren't going so well? Do we sacrifice some of our time, talent, and treasure to support their work in our parish?

As Serrans, we have committed to making support and encouragement of our Priests, seminarians, and other religious vocations a part of our life. Let's remember that the time we spend remembering them in our daily prayers and in other ways is a small sacrifice of our time when compared to the sacrifices they are making for all of us.

Congratulations to our three newly ordained Priests and our new Transitional Deacon. May they joyfully share their love of God with all of us in the Church!

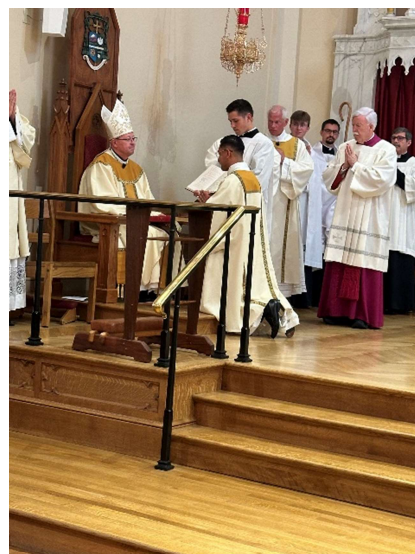


