#### President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans,

Spring has arrived and with it, a glimpse of warmer weather, long days of sunlight, the return of robins and butterflies, and the awakening of the dormant plant life. Many of us feel the same sense of new beginnings and renewal this time of the year. Lent also offers that same promise of new beginnings and renewal as we await the resurrection of Jesus, giving us a renewal of hope, faith, and the promise of eternal life.

I hope that your Lenten journey has brought you closer in relationship to God and prepared your soul to rejoice in our Risen Lord. Holy Week is almost here, a week of intense focus on the Passion and Resurrection of Jesus. This very meaningful week will include many very special opportunities to prepare for Easter. The Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday is always so powerful as the priest removes Our Lord from the main Tabernacle to repose in the temporary Tabernacle, where we can spend time in Adoration. I always think about how the disciples were asked to

spend time with Jesus on that first Holy Thursday; we also can spend some time with Him on that evening. Good Friday includes Stations of the Cross and Veneration of the Cross and Tenebrae. The church always feels so empty to me with the doors of the Tabernacle thrown open, the red light extinguished, and the holy water fonts dry. Holy Saturday in my parish offers the opportunity for the sacrament of Reconciliation and a blessing of Easter Baskets. The beautiful Easter Vigil is one of my favorite liturgies of the year. I love when the Gloria is sung again and the bells of the church ring out in joy along with bells throughout the congregation. The week ends with the peace and joy of Easter Sunday Mass. My prayer is that each of you and your families will experience a blessed and joyous Holy Week.

Thanks to Fr. Kyle for providing a meaningful Lenten Morning of Reflection on March 22 at St. Mary's Cathedral. It was such a wonderful way to spend a morning with fellow Serrans. Special thanks to Jerry and Yvonne Schaefer and Susan Curtis for providing delicious food and to all those who helped with set up and clean up.

Our Annual Anniversary Dinner is April 28. This is always a very special event in celebration of another year of our Saint Serra Apostolate. Please consider inviting a Priest or other clergy members as your guest. You can also invite others that might be interested in learning more about Serra. The food is always delicious, the guest speaker meaningful, the silent auction an opportunity to purchase items and support our mission, and the chance to socialize with other Serrans and clergy is priceless!
