WHAT IS THE 2025 JUBILEE?

Pope Francis declared December 24, 2024—January 6, 2026 to be the Jubilee Year of Hope, a “Holy Year marked by the hope that does not fade, our hope in God.” During this Jubilee Year marking the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation, we are called to be pilgrims of hope, living witnesses who proclaim the joy and hope of Christ to the modern world. We are invited to deeper conversion, relying on and trusting in God’s mercy and renewing our hope in Christ.

THE JUBILEE INDULGENCE

Indulgences are a “way of discovering the unlimited nature of God’s mercy,” according to the Holy Father. During the Jubilee Year, the Church offers many opportunities to receive a special plenary indulgence.

WHAT IS AN INDULGENCE?

An indulgence is the remission of temporal (earthly) punishment from sins that have already been forgiven through the merits of Jesus Christ.

Pope Francis notes in *Spes Non Confudit*, the papal bull announcing the Year of Hope, that “every sin ‘leaves its mark.’ Sin has consequences, not only outwardly in the effects of the wrong we do, but also inwardly, inasmuch as ‘every sin, even venial, entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures, which must be purified either here on earth, or after death, in the state called Purgatory.’ In our humanity, weak and attracted by evil, certain residual effects of sin remain. These are removed by the indulgence, always by the grace of Christ.”

A plenary indulgence removes all of the temporal punishment of sin, while a partial indulgence removes some of the temporal punishment.

WHAT ARE THE ESSENTIAL COMPONENTS OF AN INDULGENCE?

- Be a practicing Catholic
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (within about 8 days)
 - Holy Communion
 - No attachment to sin
- Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father
- Perform the work to which the indulgence is attached

SECOND DAILY PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR SOULS IN PURGATORY

The exceptional part of this Jubilee is the opportunity for a second daily plenary indulgence offered for a soul in purgatory. The requirements are:

- Receive Holy Communion a second time in the same day
- Perform an act of charity on behalf of the souls in purgatory
