President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans,

June ushers in what we think of as the beginning of summer. It is a season of growth for vegetation, of warmer days with more hours of daylight. It is a time for school kids and those working in education to take a little break. June is a month of new beginnings as seeds are sown, flowers, bushes and trees are planted, and we look forward to the possibility of enjoying all the flowers and lovingly planted vegetables later in the summer.

For those of us in the Catholic Church, June is also a beginning of sorts. We have a new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV. I think just about everybody was surprised that the Holy Spirit worked through the conclave to elect this Chicago born Augustinian to be the next Pope. We will learn about Pope Leo more as time goes by, but he seems to be a man of compassion and mercy with a deep love for Our Lady and God. Over the last months, the leadership of the two parishes have been working together and with Diocesan personnel to work out the details, to get to know one another, to prepare for a merger of staff, finances, and people. Change is challenging, but God is calling us to this new mission and Deacon Rob always reminds me that God is in control and everything will be okay. Your prayers for all of us as we embark on this new journey are much appreciated.

As you can tell, I've been thinking a lot about that sense of new beginnings and possibilities. As Serrans, we have accepted an invitation from God to pray for and support those already ordained, those in

formation, and those who are discerning. We are called to embrace the possibilities of new seminarians and other religious and to support those in formation and those already ordained so that they will be constantly freshened and renewed in their vocation.

But it takes the prayers and work of all Serrans to maximize our efforts. As you personally experience your own new beginnings, please take some time to quietly reflect on your commitment to being a Serran. Pray that God send you grace to see the possibilities in how you might use your time and talents in service to the Serra mission.
