#### President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans,

Hard to believe that July is already here, along with the long, often hot days, the summer rainstorms, the green grass and foliage and the beautiful flowers. July feels like it is the center point between spring and fall as we realize how long it has been since the start of spring and how little time lies ahead before fall. For many, July is a time of hellos and goodbyes. I saw pictures of the new cadets being dropped off at the Air Force Academy- pictures of fond goodbyes with family and the slightly overwhelmed faces of these young men and women as they left their families behind and entered the school. It has been a daunting task over these last months to figure out the logistics of this huge new venture- so many details to work out, so many plans to be made, so many meetings to be held by so many. Like any big change, there have been and will continue to be bumps in the road, but we are trying to be proactive and keep our eyes on the tremendous honor of becoming The Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mother of the Divine Redeemer.

As the St. Serra Apostolate, we have also had to say goodbye to a few members who have resigned for different reasons plus a final goodbye slated for July 12<sup>th</sup> to our long-time member, Helene Knapp.

Helene's family is inviting all who have known her to attend her Memorial Mass and reception on July 12, 2025, 11:00 a.m. at St. Paul parish, 9 El Pomar Rd. By the grace of God, we have also been able to say hello to eight new members in the recent months.

Whatever hellos and goodbyes are in our own personal lives, we can be assured of finding peace in our faith. Please continue to pray for all those already ordained, those in formation, and those discerning.

Comments by Eleanor Gentilini:

- For the Rocky Mountain Region, we had 9 Serrans from District 6 (State of Colorado), 3 of whom were from Colorado Springs.
- Our International Episcopal Moderator, Cardinal Thomas Collins of Toronto, gave a talk on his Conclave Experience which was most interesting and informative.
- Sister Nancy Rose, a member of the first class at West Point that admitted women, later worked in banking and finance, before entering religious life in 2006.
- Other speakers included our US Serra Chaplin, Bishop Daly; Bishops of Kansas City, Missouri and Kansas; Abbot of Conception Abbey; three Vocations Directors; President of Benedictine College.
- For Adoration we were fortunate to have the monstrance blessed by St. Pope John Paul II for an increase in Vocations. This monstrance is available for use in parishes and schools around the US.
