President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans,
Priesthood Sunday in 2025 will be on Sunday, September 28, 2025. This day is a special occasion for the Catholic Church to honor the service of priests and to encourage young people to consider a vocation to the priesthood. As Serrans, part of our mission is to support those already ordained to the Priesthood. We can fulfill this call through our prayers for our Priests, but also by building a relationship with them, taking the time to thank them personally, to thank them for teaching us and inspiring us to grow in our relationship to God. We should not assume they already know that we love and support them; let's remember to be intentional in expressing our love and support!

We are also called to be a friend to our seminarians, those men who are currently in a long and intense process leading to ordination. We now have twenty-one men in formation for our diocese. It is important that we support them in prayer daily, but I think we might underestimate the importance of a letter from "home," a card with a short message of support and promise of prayer, a note or text to encourage and uplift them throughout the year. These men have chosen the "less traveled path" by attending the seminary instead of the more widely traveled paths to vocations in the married or single life. It took courage for them to respond to God's call, and it takes stamina, hard work, and faith to travel the difficult path leading to the Priesthood.

Support, encouragement, friendship, prayer- it's what we are called to do as Serrans.

Thursday, August 21 Serra Monthly Lunch and Program

Our Speaker was Serran Robert Applegate.

Our Programs theme this year is the Jubilee of HOPE, so Robert talked about the year of Hope and also the history of the jubilee year of Hope. He mentioned highlights and interesting aspects of the Jubilees that have been happening since the year 1300.

In February of 1300, Pope Boniface VIII, in the papal bull *Antiquorum Habet Fida Relatio*, declared the first-ever Catholic Jubilee Year. Anyone who made a pilgrimage to the tombs of the Apostles Peter and Paul in Rome, and who repented and confessed, would receive "the fullest and broadest pardon for all sins committed," Boniface proclaimed.

Dante references the "jubilee" in Inferno, Canto XVIII, comparing the two lines of sinners moving in opposite directions to the two-way traffic system created on the [Bridge of Angels](#) during the 1300 Jubilee of Rome, an event he likely witnessed as a pilgrim.

2025 is the Jubilee Holy Year, the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord, an "event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church."

The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home.

Everyone is encouraged to look up the Jubilee of Hope online to get more interesting information!

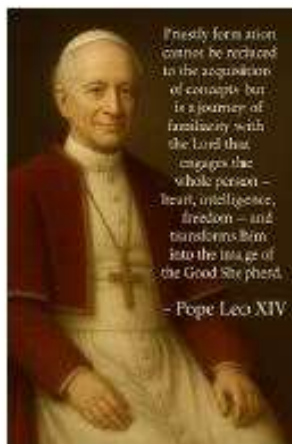

For those who missed the funeral of Janelle O'Keeffe:

Former Serra Member Janelle O'Keeffe passed away on Friday July 18th. She and her husband Dave are a big part of why we have Serra in Colorado Springs. Janelle's funeral was August 19 at 2pm at the Newman Center, 4785 Stanton Road Colorado Springs, CO 80918. Janelle will be buried next to her husband Dave at Pikes Peak National Cemetery.



Born on November 19, 1932, in Nashville, Tennessee, Janelle was the daughter of Stanley and Virginia Louise Cortner. Proud of her deep roots in Tennessee, she was honored to be a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution and part of the Scots-Irish community that helped settle Robertson County in northern Tennessee.

Janelle graduated from Vanderbilt University in 1954 and began a career as a stewardess—an exciting profession at the time. During a layover in Dallas, she met a young Army lieutenant named Dave O'Keeffe at a party. That night sparked a long-distance courtship filled with love letters the family still cherishes. The two were married on June 5, 1955, in Nashville.

The O'Keeffes welcomed five children over the next decade—David Jr., John, Karen, Jennifer, and Timothy. As Dave's career with IBM led to frequent relocations every few years, Janelle skillfully managed each move, building homes and communities from scratch, all while raising a growing family. Their final family home was in Lake Oswego, Oregon, where all five children graduated from high school before heading out into the world.

In their later years, Janelle and Dave lived in Falls Church, Virginia, before settling in Colorado Springs, where they made their home at Kissing Camels, McKenzie Place, and eventually Sunny Vista.

Janelle was a devoted Catholic, giving much of her time in service to others. She played the organ at Mass, volunteered with the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, and was active in the Serra Club. She loved reading, but her true recreational passion was cards—especially Bridge, where she was widely regarded as a formidable and talented player.

Above all, Janelle was deeply committed to her family. She crisscrossed the country to visit her children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren, forming strong, lasting bonds with each generation. Her kindness, warmth, generosity, and playful spirit live on in her five children, 11 grandchildren, and 13 great-grandchildren.
