President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans,

Lent is a time of preparation, a time of reflection, a time of almsgiving and fasting, a time of anticipation. I was thinking about this as I prepared to write this article, and it struck me that life itself often mirrors the themes of Lent. Throughout the stages of our life, we prepare for the next stage- infancy to childhood, school age to adult, adult to old age. We anticipate the events of a usual life- reception of sacraments, graduations, college, marriage, career. We reflect along the way and sometimes alter our course based on that reflection. There are times in our life when we feast and all is going well, but those are balanced by times in our life when we "fast"- times of sickness, sorrow, set-backs, challenges. We hopefully learn along the way how to be good citizens, faithful Catholics, generous with the gifts we are given- almsgiving in the sense that we are called to give back to our family, our community, our church. All of these things of an ordinary life hopefully will lead to spending eternity with God in heaven- the ultimate goal of all of us.

In our own diocese now, we also are going through some of these same things- sorrow, uncertainty, anticipation, hope- as we bid Archbishop-designate Golka a fond farewell. We await the naming of a new Shepherd for our diocese, a process that likely will take an extended period of time. As we await, we need to be praying for whoever it is that the Holy Spirit will lead Pope Leo to appoint and be ready to welcome our new Bishop with open arms and open hearts. Like all major changes throughout life, there likely will be challenges as this process unfolds, but we can pray through the challenges!

As this Lenten season continues and Easter draws ever nearer, remember to spend time in prayer for all the clergy and religious already ordained and consecrated, for those who are in formation, and for those discerning what God is calling them to become.

May your Lenten Journey be thoughtful, joyful, prayerful and fruitful!

“You can drop off food any time after 4:45pm. Confessions and Adoration start at 5. If you need to drop off earlier, let me know so I can be sure someone is at the center. Our numbers vary but you can plan on 35-40 students. We ask that you provide a main dish, a side dish or salad, and a dessert. We provide paper products, all utensils, and drinks.

Mass is at 5:30 and dinner at 6:15. Usually there are announcements and a meal prayer before dinner. We will do the set up and clean up. You are welcome to attend the Mass and dinner. I will email you the week before your designated week and update the numbers and give you what has been cooked the previous Thursdays.

We do have several gluten free students, so if your meal includes something that is gluten free, please let me know. You don't have to cook a complete gluten free meal.

We're done by 7:00-7:15. Some nights they have a speaker after that. You're welcome to stay for the presentation.”

Dear Lord,


