Dear Fellow Serrans,

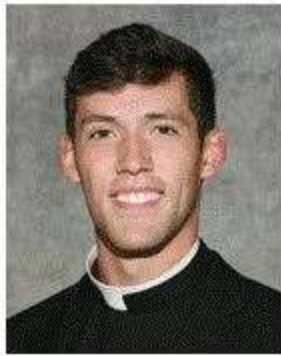

US Serra Leadership Rally, St. Louis MO January 22-25, 2026

Convention Location: Augustine Institute
(Ray Gentilini's report and reflections on the annual Serra Leadership Rally)

The Serra Apostolate of Colorado Springs was well represented at the Serra Leadership Rally in St. Louis, MO, January 22-25, 2026. Jerry Schaefer, Ray and Eleanor Gentilini and Rose Marie Stimpfl were all in attendance. Father Kyle had planned to join us but had to officiate at a funeral. Additionally, Nancy Akers, our District 6 Governor and other Serrans from Denver attended. The Rocky Mountain Region, which includes all of Colorado, also had members from Phoenix and El Paso, a total of 18. International Serrans joined us from Canada, Mexico, Italy, India, Scotland and Switzerland.

The Rally was held at the incredible Augustine Institute, recently moved from Denver. Many minor miracles had to happen for the Institute to buy this state-of-the-art facility. The former Boeing corporate retreat center was completely refurbished and upgraded just before the COVID shutdown. Since it could not be used and Boeing was strapped for cash at the time, they sold this tremendous venue for only \$20 million. The Augustine Institute then made only a few changes, such as converting a ballroom to a magnificent chapel where their students and our Serrans were able to attend daily Mass.

This year the Rally was revised to focus on leadership with an abiding theme of prayer throughout the entire event. We were reminded that prayer fosters an intimacy with Jesus and a place from which to make the best decisions. This idea was reinforced by all the speakers including USA Council Episcopal Advisor Bishop Thomas A. Daly of Spokane, St. Louis Archbishop Mitchell T. Rozanski, and Kenrick-Glennon Seminary Rector Fr. Paul Hoelsing.

All those in attendance, to include the office staff from Chicago, agreed that this was the best Rally in years. The new format makes it more useful for all attendees as almost all were officers in their respective clubs. A first-time attendee who was a relatively new Serran said, *"For my first rally, I was warmly welcomed by every attendee I met. In conversations I expanded my "very limited" knowledge of Serra and gained valuable tips to take back to my Club. I found the rally extremely well organized with a sense of priority and mission. Every speaker added to my knowledge, and all conveyed a sense of sharing."*

If you have never participated in a large Serra function, now is the time to start. The next Serra International Convention will be July 9-12, 2026, in Indianapolis. **The next Serra Leadership Rally will be held January 28-31, 2027**, at the Franciscan Renewal Center, known as The Casa, in Scottsdale, AZ, part of our Rocky Mountain Region. Watch for your next copy of the Serran Magazine that will have more coverage of this past Rally and information on the coming convention in July. Be bold! Register now for what will be an invigorating, inspiring, prayerful and fun time with fellow Serrans from around the world.





