President Janet Zabukovic's Message



Dear Fellow Serrans,

This past month has certainly been a reminder of the unpredictability of life. It has also been a reminder of the power of faith, the power of prayer, the dedication of medical professionals, and the compassion of those who work in our hospitals to care for the sick.

After experiencing what seemed minor issues- tension in the jaw- when I was walking and pushing up my heart rate, I found myself referred to a cardiologist, Dr. Yarlagadda at UCHealth. After an exam and EKG, she referred me for a chemical stress test on May 4. When I was in the recovery room following the stress test, I was told that it was not safe for me to go back home and I needed to be immediately admitted to the hospital for cardiac care, which included an angiogram early the next morning. I knew things were critical when my son arranged to fly in early that next

morning to be with me for the procedure. That test revealed a 95% blockage in the major artery supplying blood to my heart and a 90% blockage in the right artery that branched off from that major artery. After stenting was ruled out due to the location of the blockages, I was scheduled for open heart surgery early the morning of May 7. In those days before the surgery, I had a lot of time to think, to worry, to be afraid. But the encouragement of my doctors and care givers, my family and my friends, and my faith combined to give me the courage to face this major surgery.

The surgery was deemed a success- a double bypass along with aortic valve replacement- and after over a week in cardiac intensive care and then almost a week on the cardiac care floor, I was released to come home and start the long road to healing and recovery. This journey to recovery will likely last about six months, but I know that my faith, prayers, and the encouragement of family and friends will see me through.

As I reflect on what has happened, several things really stand out for me. First, I was blessed to be anointed prior to surgery by Fr. Kyle, and the grace and peace that came with that anointing helped me manage my stress prior to the surgery. As I recovered in intensive care, both of the Memorial hospital chaplains visited. Fr. Mohan visited soon after the surgery, as did Fr Kyle who

also brought me Communion. Fr. Larry Solon also visited me in intensive care and anointed me again, which brought great peace. Those experiences remind me of the necessity for there to be priests available to minister to the sick and dying. When you need a priest, you need a priest! The day of the angiogram, a Lutheran chaplain visited and offered to pray with me. I appreciated the prayers, but when she told me that she knew she couldn't do what a priest could do- anoint me prior to the procedure- I told her that was true and that I hoped I could connect with one of the Catholic priest chaplains before surgery. I didn't mean to be rude, but only a priest could give me what I needed- anointing.

Another thing that stood out is the power of prayer. I knew that my fellow Serrans were praying along with my family and friends, and I felt the power of their prayers. I felt as though Jesus was wrapping his healing arms around me to keep me safe and that Our Blessed Mother kept me under the mantle of her protection. All those prayers made a difference. Prayer matters. Prayer works. Prayer is essential in our lives and not just when we are in a crisis.

Finally, I was reminded (as I had been two and a half years ago when I almost died of sepsis from pneumonia) of the goodness, the compassion, the professionalism, and the dedication of medical professionals. I was surrounded by people who cared, who listened, who explained, who did their best to help me get better. That care extended through the whole gamut of hospital workers- doctors, nurses, other medical professionals, therapists, caregivers, those who provided nutritious food and those who kept my room clean and organized. I felt like it mattered to them that I get well. I felt listened to and I felt safe. May God bless all those whose life work is caring for the sick!

I am saddened to miss the ordinations this year, but I will watch the livestream with joy for three new priests. Please continue to pray for an increase in vocations to the Priesthood and religious life, for those already ordained, for those in formation, and for those discerning. And please continue to pray for me that each day I get a little stronger, have a little more endurance and stamina. I hope to see you all in person at some point this summer. Until then, please also pray for each other!
